RIGHT OF WAY TRIMMING

Property owners are responsible for trimming and maintaining vegetation on or adjacent to their property in order to keep it from interfering with the public right-of-way.

Sidewalks: For a clear pathway, keep tree limbs and other vegetation trimmed back from the edge of the sidewalk and at least **8 feet** above sidewalks.

Streets/Alleys: Keep tree limbs and vegetation trimmed back from the edge of the street or alley and at least **14 feet** above streets, bicycle lanes and alleys.

Please do your part to keep Cornelius' sidewalks and streets safe and accessible.

Cada propietario es responsable de podar y mantener la vegetación en o adyacente a su propiedad para evitar que interfiera con el derecho de vía público.

Para un camino libre, mantenga las ramas de los árboles y otra vegetación recortada desde el borde de la banqueta y al menos **8 pies** (2.5 metros) por encima de las banquetas.

Calles / Callejones: Mantenga las ramas de los árboles y la vegetación recortadas desde el borde de la calle o callejón y al menos **14 pies** (4.25 metros) por encima de las calles, carriles para bicicletas y callejones.

Por favor, haga su parte para mantener seguras y accesibles las aceras y calles de Cornelius.
