## CORNELIUS 2045 OUTREACH SUMMARY FEBRUARY 29<sup>TH</sup>, 2024

Beginning in August 2023, City staff and the consultant team led outreach efforts to better understand the Community's vision and priorities related to Cornelius' future. As of February 2024, the *Cornelius 2045* process has reached over 1,000 community members through Community Conversations, Community Events, an online survey, and the project website. The purpose of the outreach effort was to ask the following questions:

- What makes Cornelius special?
- What do you want to protect or enhance in Cornelius?
- What would you like to change or improve in Cornelius for the future?

The following is an initial accounting of the engagement activities to date\*:

- National Night Out
  - August 1<sup>st</sup>
  - 2 staff members were present.
  - Reached approximately 500 people.
- Cornelius Farmer's Market (August and September)
  - August 25<sup>th</sup> and September 1<sup>st</sup>
  - 1 staff member at each market appearance.
  - Each attendance reached approximately 10-15 people.
- El Grito
  - September 16<sup>th</sup>
  - 3 staff members were present.
  - Reached approximately 40-50 people, including 12-15 Spanish speakers.
- Community Dinner/ Vision Summit #1
  - November 18<sup>th</sup>
  - 6 staff members were present.
  - Approximately 500 participants attended the dual event at the Cornelius Elementary School, where the annual Cornelius Community Dinner was being held and offered a free meal and crafts for kids. A wide range of participants included Spanish speaking residents, newcomers and residents who had lived in Cornelius for their entire life.
- Career and Technical Education High School Students Conversations
  - December 8<sup>th</sup>
  - 3 staff members were present.
  - Spoke with approximately 25 students.

While there was variation in how these broad questions were posed across different activities, they are designed to identify common themes around the aspirations and concerns of a community, which are a key piece to the development of a community-wide Vision Statement. After each engagement activity, all information received was reviewed and stored within the online survey either through individual survey responses or manual input (which is noted within the survey system) of responses from the variety of events.

This summary provides an update on the various outreach efforts and summarizes the preliminary vision and key themes that are emerging from these activities via tagging of community conversation and event notes, as well as survey responses. The following

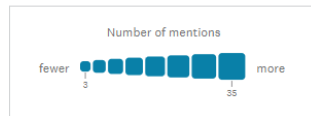

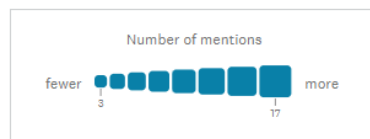

Q2. What do you want to protect or enhance in Cornelius?



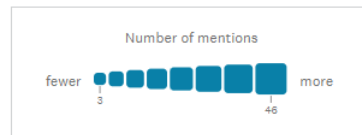
